

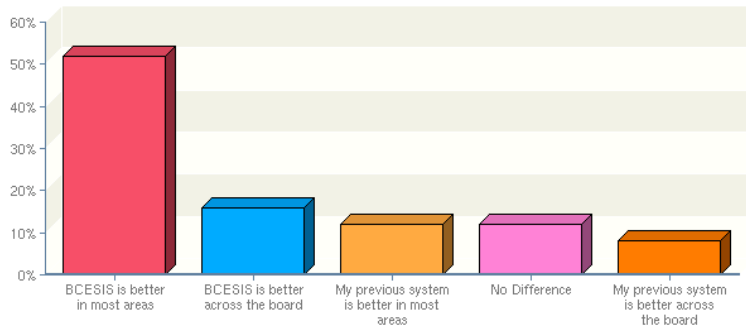

**1. How would you compare BCESIS for report cards to your past system?**



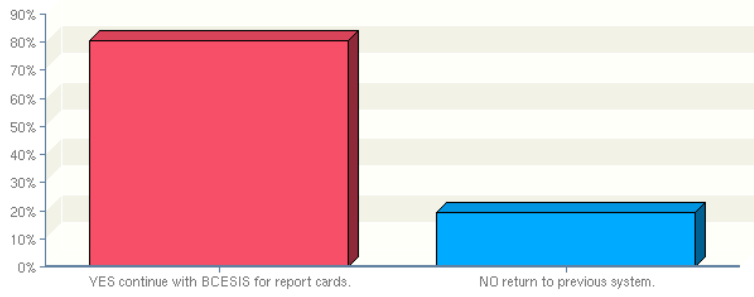

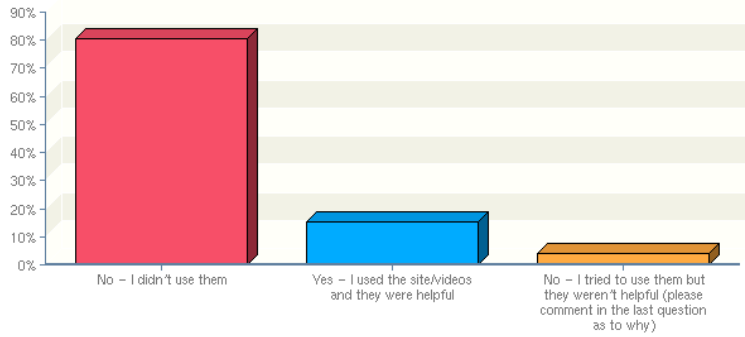

I feel frustrated with the little glitches that are there i.e: not transferring from word to BCeSIS, printing a class with primary and intermediate, teachers not able to print report cards. Overall I would like to keep using BCeSIS for Report Cards, and I am sure all will work out.
33861164	The system worked perfectly for me. I will get better at writing comments to make things simpler next year. I had no problems and really like the simplicity of the system and the professional look of the reports. Thanks
33860732	One of the main problem with BCeSis is that the system has many failure (it was down at some times during our last reporting period) and that we have to have internet access to use it. Also, there are many anoying things like : - when you have started writing a comment, you can't delete it until you've written something in both spaces. - you cannot move your comment up or down the list for a better management of your comments. - when you try to change a comment already made, there is often an error message that won't let you do it. - there is no spell check. - you cannot select and slide items in the big comment box. All of these, make bcesis a little tedious to work with. It feels a little backward/dinosaurish. The idea is good though. If these things could be fixed, it would be much more useful and pleasant to work with.
33864082	I think the comment bank is cumbersome to use. It would be more useful if teachers could create comments in another program (Notepad) and paste into the student's comments
33865511	Some staff members had difficulty using the system?? But I didn't. I found it quick, easy and less stressful.
33874696	Wonderful! Please continue this format!
33892754	Although BCesis was better in most areas, the flaws that it did/does have makes it not a system I would want to use in the future. Too many issues overall: losing saved work, system down at inconvenient times, not able to use at home without downloading an unprotected tool, difficult to make changes if it is an error in a canned comment bank (can't find and correct all). Report writer is still used in the district and has so many rave about it. It needs to be looked at for entire district to use.

CODE	VALUE
33921961	I found this reporting time easier now that I have used BCESIS for a longer time period. I would really like it if there were a spelling/grammar check function that could be used directly in the program, it would help a lot with minor errors.
33930226	Internet use at home is still an issue for teachers that live out of town - using their own internet time or having to use gas to go to town on weekends to do reports. Access was not always available so not convenient. Some options to consider for future - spell check, having a general spot for prep or 2nd teacher so they don't have to type their names under each comment for subject they are teaching.
33951646	BCeSIS was "down" at inconvenient times, making report writing frustrating. This process requires additional time, something teachers do not have at reporting periods. As a prep teacher working with academic subjects, I have several students with I letter grades. Waiting for these students to come to school, be released from office/in-school suspensions, etc. means that I am not always able to complete all of my reports at one time. Previously, I wrote separate reports that were inserted into envelopes along with other reports. Classroom teachers were not required to wait for my reports to be complete before they could print their reports. Having to include my reports on the same template as classroom teachers adds further frustration and complexity to what was a relatively simple process..
34009553	For the most part, BCeSIS was O.K. It is good to be able to access it from home. On the negative side, using an apostrophe is difficult. We get upside down question marks. It sure would be helpful to have a spell check.
34032287	It is absolutely important to have a spell-check on this as it is creating a lot of extra work that is totally not necessary.
34617001	I found it a convenient, efficient way to do report cards.
34690018	I find the system quite frustrating and not user friendly. It freezes often and when you cut and paste (because there is no spell check and grammar check in it) it converts simple punctuation signs into weird ones. When you make a mistake you can't correct all the report at once you have to go and do it individually. I like the idea of having a province wide report template, but all the flaws in this one is not worth my time and energy.
35129085	I am not in favor of this new model. It is not as easy to personalize report cards, you have to click to get forward and back to any other part and it does not have a spell check. I would much rather be using a word document or other format.
35350369	I had a lot of trouble this term however, I also had a lot of support and I was able to complete my reports on time. When all goes well I like the system but when things go wrong it is scary to not have a back up plan.
